NOTES:

1. Official E.F.A. measurements for current season will be accepted. Registration papers of breed horses must be shown on demand.
2. Ringmaster reserves the right to delete or alter Classes at his discretion.
3. All contestants participate at their own risk and must be suitably attired and equipped for individual events.
4. This society enforces the wearing of suitable ASA approved helmets in horse events. Competitors entering in events that clash must supply another rider.
5. Stables must be booked through Nominate. No booking No stable. You will be asked to move.
6. All rings on both days will be running outside the main arena over near the cross country jumps
7. ALL ELECTRIC FENCING NEEDS TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASC RULES. Electrical Notice: Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the show ground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 2000. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non - compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Barraba showground. Please check all your electrical equipment and leads before you arrive to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.
8. Registration papers of breed horses must be shown on demand
9. Competitors entering in events that clash must supply another rider.

HORSE DRUG TESTING

DRUG TESTING MAY BE CARRIED OUT AT THIS SHOW. DRUG TESTING RULES WILL BE DISPLAYED IN THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE. ANY COMPETITOR FOUND TO HAVE BREACHED THE ASC DISPUTES AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS WILL BE INVESTIGATED BY THE ASC DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE.

DEFINITIONS:

MAIDEN: A horse that has not won or placed in any individual ridden hack class at any Ag/Official show.

NOVICE: A horse that has not been placed first in any Individual Open ridden hack class at any Ag/Official show. Same applies to Show Hunters.

NOVICE RIDER: Is one who has not won a 1st in an individual class at an Ag/Official show. On attaining the age of 17yrs a successful Junior may compete as a Novice Adult Rider.

INTERMEDIATE: A horse that has not been placed first, second or third in any individual hack class at any Royal show. Same applies to Show Hunters.

ELEMENTARY: A horse has not won 3 firsts in any individual Open hack class at any Ag/Official show or Show Hunter show. Same applies to Show Hunters

DISTRICT: All horses must be owned by the rider or immediate family member. Riders must reside in the Shire or go to a school in Barraba. Pony Club uniform or Show class attire to be worn. Helmets with chin strap, smooth sole riding boots.

CHILD & ADULT HACK CLASSES: Horses cannot compete in both.

SHOW HUNTERS: Cannot compete in Open Hack classes. Show Hunters must have been shown as a Show Hunter at the start of 2023. Members classes-Horses must be registered with the Australian Hunter and Show Horse Association and owner/rider must be a financial member to be eligible to compete in MEMBERS classes. Member numbers needed upon win/placing.

2ND CHANCE CLASSES: Excludes first place in open class (Sunday) Champions or Reserves in first rounds.

NEWCOMER: A Horse that has not been shown or competed under saddle, (racing excepted), prior to the 1st of January 2023 in its first year of being shown or competing. Once shown under saddle, such horse ceases to be a NEWCOMER on the 31st December that same year. All horses in NEWCOMER classes shall be shown in a snaffle bit.

BREED COMPETITORS: All Breed horses must be registered with their relevant Breed Society/Associations. All Handlers/Riders must also be financial members of the relevant Breed Society/Association. Registrations/memberships must be produced on request.

STALLIONS: Are only eligible to compete in their respective Breed classes only. And handled by a person 18yrs and over. They must have a bit in their mouth and must be doubled tied at their truck/floats

A HACK: must be at least 3 years of age to compete in ridden classes at Ag/Official classes. No Individual apart from competitors are to be in the ring at any time. No COACHING from ring side.

JUDGES DECISION: IS FINAL NO COACHING from the side lines.

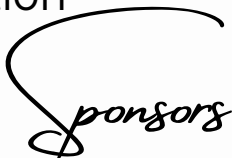

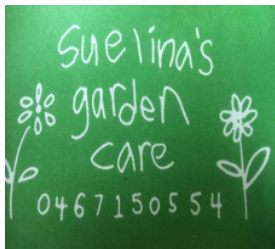
