Competitors entering in events that clash must supply another rider.



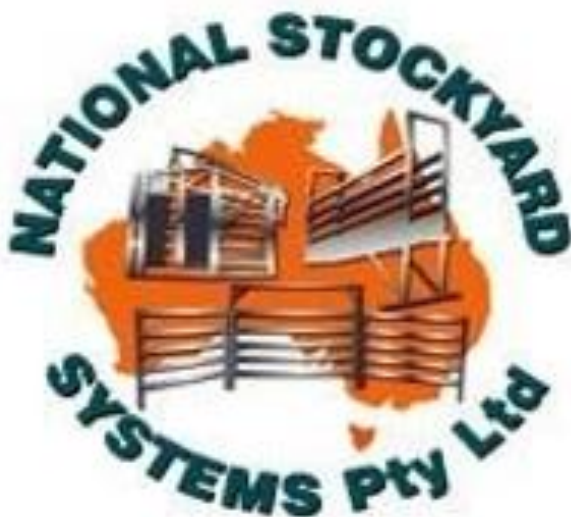

DEFINITIONS

MAIDEN: A horse that has not won or placed in any individual ridden hack class at any Ag/Official show.

NOVICE: A horse that has not been placed first in any Individual Open ridden hack class at any Ag/Official show. Same applies to **Show Hunters**.

INTERMEDIATE: A horse that has not been placed first, second or third in any individual hack class at any Royal show. Same applies to Show Hunters.

ELEMENTARY: A horse has not won 3 firsts in any individual Open hack class at any Ag/Official show or Show Hunter show. Same applies to Show Hunters

DISTRICT: All horses must have resided in the Shire 3 months before the show date. Riders must reside in the Shire or go to a school in Barraba. Pony Club uniform or Show class attire to be worn. Helmets with chin strap, smooth sole riding boots must be worn

DISTRICT CONSOLATION: Horses who haven't won/placed in a District class.

CHILD & ADULT HACK CLASSES: Horses cannot compete in both.

SHOW HUNTERS: Cannot compete in Open Hack classes on Sunday. Show Hunters must have been shown as a Show Hunter at the start of 2018.

BREED COMPETITORS: All Breed horses must be registered with their relevant Breed Society/Associations. All Handlers/Riders must also be financial members of the relevant Breed Society/Association. Registrations/memberships must be produced on request.

SECOND GO ROUND CLASSES: 1st **Champion and Reserve not Eligible to compete.**

Stallions: Are only Eligible to compete in their respective Breed classes. JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

PROTEST: Must be in writing within 10 minutes of class finishing along with \$50 non-refundable deposit.

All rings on both days will be running outside the main arena at the Southern end of the showground.

NO ANIMAL TO BE TIED TO RUNNING RAIL

NO ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED IN THE JUDGING ARENA

Electrical Notice: Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the show ground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Occupational Health and Safety Act of 2000. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non - compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Barraba showground. **Please check all your electrical equipment and leads before you arrive to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.**

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

We are a Biosecurity Aware Show:

The Barraba P.A & H. Association Inc. is aware that biosecurity is an important issue when you consider exhibiting your livestock at our show. We have endeavoured to provide an environment that is as pest and disease free as possible in a show environment. However, while we continue to try to provide a safe environment for our exhibitors, you are ultimately responsible for your own biosecurity. You should make your own risk assessment of our facilities and act accordingly. Please use common sense.

The following advice from Animal Health Australia may help you make valid decisions – Responsibility for biosecurity doesn't end when your livestock leave the farm gate. By implementing good management practices in your farming operation, you'll be playing an important role in protecting your region, and possibly the entire industry, from devastating disease outbreaks. These practical measures will help ensure your biosecurity practices extend into the wider community:

Moving animals off your property -

- Make sure your animals are fit to travel before loading. Diseased/injured animals should not be moved off property and if necessary you should seek veterinary attention.
- Supply a NVD/TSS/PIC and animal health declaration

Taking animals to shows –

- Ensure pens/housing areas are clean before they enter
- Feed and water your livestock separately, if possible
- Never share equipment – if you must, always clean & disinfect before and after use
- Isolate any returning stock for 10 days to allow for weed seed elimination and signs of diseases and pests
- Further information that can assist you in making an informed decision can be found at www.farmbiosecurity.com.au
- Dogs to be vaccinated for Parvovirus.

JOHNE'S DISEASE: Exhibitors will be required to have a signed Sheep Health Declaration. All competitors and exhibitors are asked to abide by the Association Rules and Regulations posted at the Secretary's Office.

All exhibitors and competitors are advised to hold their own public liability insurance policy. Exhibitors in all Sections participate and exhibit at their own risk and are required to sign a waiver form to include with entries.

Exhibitors are kindly requested to have their Entry Forms, Waiver Forms and Fees to the Steward or Secretary as early as possible.

Exhibitors are kindly requested to advise the Secretary at least three days prior to the Opening Day of the Show if they do not intend exhibiting the exhibits they have entered.
